

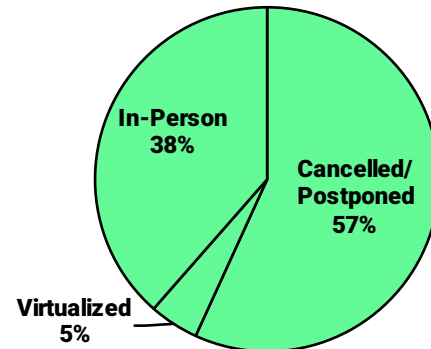
Germany: International Cultural Activities 2020

In 2020, 402 Dutch artists and cultural organizations participated in 912 cultural activities across Germany. These activities took place at 454 venues across 160 cities in the country.

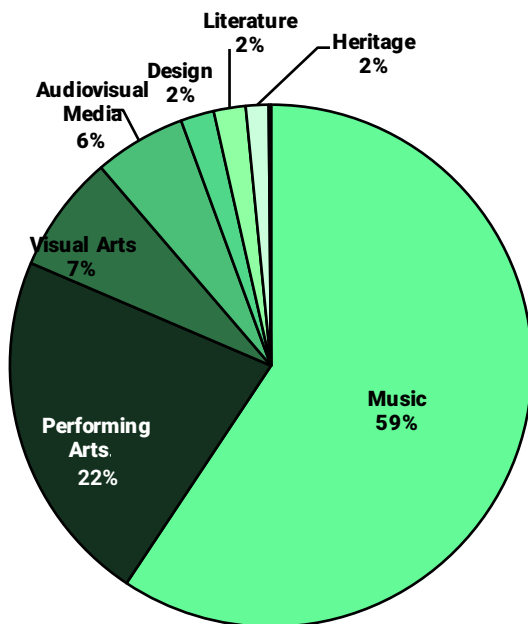

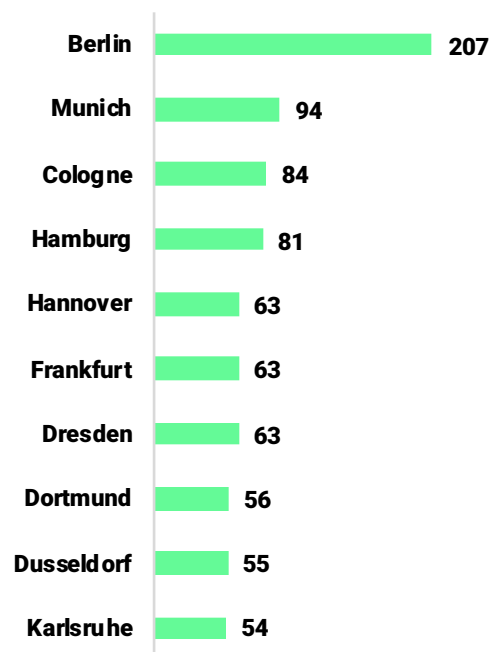
Covid-19 Impact

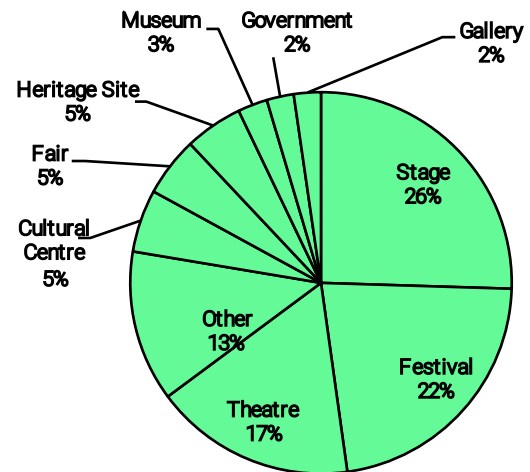

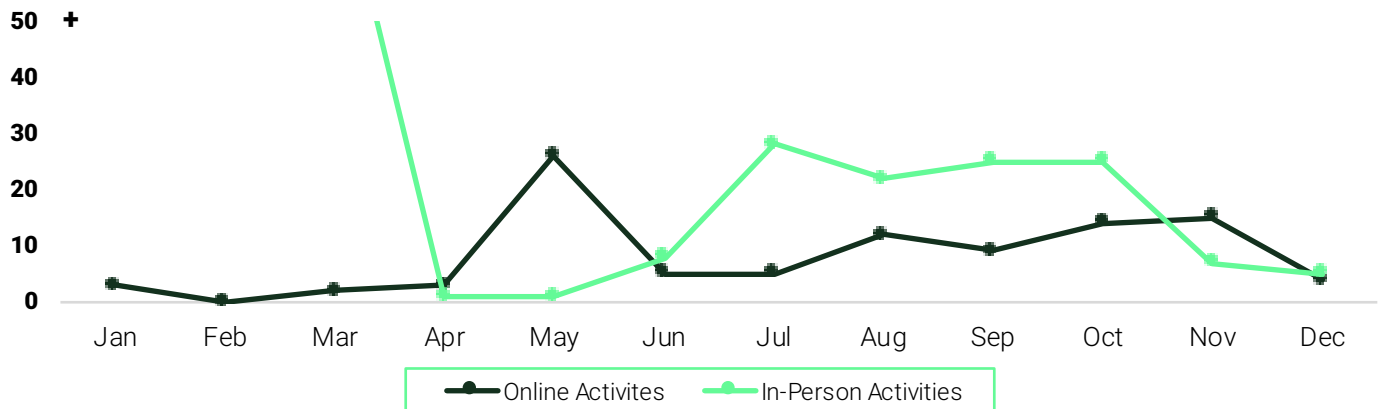
