

Teun Zwets showcases innovative furniture and installations made from reused waste materials, offering a fresh take on sustainable productdesign.





This exhibition spotlights talented productdesigners using creativity to drive sustainable industry change. **THRIVING PLANET**




Cooling down the city, NRE Terrain | Canal



<u>Koelhuis District</u> is a cultural district around Immersive Experiences (IX), new media art and contemporary culture, located at Eindhoven's new eastern city entrance. It will become a permanent place for the creative and technical community to live, work, and present. The district is developed around the former Campina freezer warehouse, an industrial heritage monument, locally known as Koelhuis.

The program in K**oelhuis** shows several cool AI projects but also immersive experiences for our Health and Wellbeing.

Like the **Eigengrau Pavilion by Zalán Szakács** is an artist who explores the relationship between space, body, and technology.
