

## | Overview of Dutch funds for culture

### **About this overview**

The Shared Cultural Heritage Matching Fund has been running for over 7 years and during this time we've received more than 150 requests for funding. The Matching Fund covers up to 50% of the total project costs and many projects were made possible with the support of other funds that subsidise cultural heritage projects in the Netherlands and abroad. To support the work of those working in the broad field of culture, we compiled a list of the funds based in the Netherlands we came across during this time. We advise you to check the website of each fund carefully, since funding schemes may have changed. Please note that this is not an exhaustive list.

### **How does it work?**

The overview includes 5 columns: the first lists the name of the funds with a hyperlink to their websites, and the second specifies the focus or theme of each fund. The overview indicates whether a fund supports projects in the Netherlands (third column), in the Shared Cultural Heritage (SCH) partner countries (fourth column), and/or in other countries (last column).

### **About the Shared Cultural Heritage programme and the Matching Fund**

The Shared Cultural Heritage programme is part of the Netherlands' International Cultural Policy. For the 2017-2020 period, the Dutch Ministries of Foreign Affairs and of Education, Culture and Science have formulated a policy for this programme that focuses on 10 partner countries: Suriname, Brazil, the United States, Russia, South Africa, India, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Japan and Australia. Funds are available for shared heritage activities via the Dutch embassies and DutchCulture. Through the Matching Fund, DutchCulture has a sum of € 200,000 per year at its disposal for shared heritage activities initiated by Dutch legal entities. An important aim for the Matching Fund is the promotion of and coherence in shared heritage activities.
